Subj: 1974 Changes of Procedure

 - CG 7. Library Assistant part time (Reference, circulation and display)
- New 8. Library assistant part-time (Childrens and adults circulation)
- (?) 9. Pages
- TS 10. Custodian
- OG 11. Assistant custodian

The reason for the changes is an obvious lack of adult staff members: pages are used at low salaries to do the work of trained adults, and most are not able nor dedicated. Pages are used in most libraries to keep the collection in order, to help with processing, but never to wait on borrowers.

In the early spring the trustees were successful in engaging Edwin B. Colburn, a man of broad background and exceptional experience in the library field, as new head librarian. His sudden death in late October was a loss felt by trustees, staff, and patrons as well as his family. We will continue to corve as well as possible as we go through another interim period.

The Central Massachusetts Regional Library System will continue to act as our back up, with their aid in reference, inter-library loans, files, workshops, special materials for the blind and physically handicapped, and numerous other ways. Our resources are no longer bound to the materials we own here locally, but are as unlimited as any large library in the state.

Our Pioppi Meeting Room has seen increased use. This year we added the area Hot Line for both executive meetings and for two series of training sessions. The Historical Society had a four day Identification Workshop with a display of four hundred of their Aaron Peace cellection of photos, display. There were many visitors who were very helpful in identifing people and places. Dr. Masse loaned a beautiful display on archaeological discovers in Albania which graced the Pioppi Room for all of December. Along with school visits, summer reading club and weekly story hours year round, we feel we give an added service that the community can use and appreciate.

We had so many fine gifts of books given us this year, and one extra special gift of photos, postcards and memorabilia, all of Southbridge, given us by George Tucci. These have all been lovingly collected for years by Mr. Tucci, and were a handsome addition to our local history cellection.

Our fine coverage of all these events by the Evening News was greatly appreciated. The continued support of my loyal staff, and board of trustees is greatly appreciated.
