# **Bullying and Cyberbullying**

#### Bullying and Cyberbullying: Definition and Information

**Bullying** occurs when one or more students repeatedly act out against a targeted student(s) and this conduct is unfair and one-sided. It can be physical, verbal, emotional, or mental.

**Cyberbullying** occurs when the aggressive student(s) use technology such as the internet, email, or texting via cell phone to harm a target(s).

#### If you think your child may be the target of bullying, you should:

- Stay calm, listen to, support, and reassure your child.
- NEVER tell your child to fight back or respond in an aggressive way.
- Role-play to build your child's confidence to respond to aggressive peers peacefully.
- Immediately make a report to your child's school.
- Work with the school to ensure your child's safety.

Contact the Police Department if your child is in immediate danger, or if the aggressive behavior is occurring outside of school.
