- \* We need to research area craft fairs for next year. How do we get invited? Each fair would need a permit; do these permits cover out of town vendors?
- \* Next year we need to have a table at Autumn Fest even if it's just for outreach. Louise said one time we had kids decorate leaves and it was a hit.
