Minutes of February 25, 2025

James Dyer called the Library Trustee meeting of February 25, 2025 to order at 12:03 PM. Chair Report – James reminded the Trustees to complete their Conflict of Interest Training online. Public Notice Bulletin Boards Policy – Margaret will continue to monitor bulletin board usage with the new policy in effect. Internet hotspot borrowing issues have been improved, but still working on it.

Financial Report – There was no financial report at this time.

FOJEL – Bernadette Meade discussed that the 501(c)(3) application was submitted to IRS and FOJEL is still waiting for approval. FOJEL will conduct a book sale in April and books and puzzles are needed. The President of FOJEL will meet with James in the future to discuss a summary of goals.

Margaret announced that she will be retiring as Library Director in September 2025.
