## **Public Notice Bulletin Boards Policy**

Approved by Board of Trustees: September 2024

The bulletin boards in the library are available for public notices of community interest to nonprofit, advocacy and/or civic organizations sponsoring cultural, educational and/or recreational events, subject to the following guidelines:

Items that in the staff's judgment do not meet the criteria such as commercial, personal, lost-and-found, solicitations, or political notices or petitions will not be posted.

- 1. All notices must be brought to the attention of the staff for approval, and include the name, address and phone number of a contact person.
- 2. There is no limit to the number of different notices an individual or organization may post at the library in the course of a given year.
- 3. Notices posted without authorization will be removed.
- 4. Notices may remain posted for as long as the information remains current.
- 5. Notices posted become library property and will be disposed of when the information no longer is current or at the discretion of the library staff.
- 6. Those notices posted in violation of this policy will be removed and discarded.
- 7. Petitions of any kind may not be posted or circulated at the library.

Posting of materials does not imply Library endorsement or consent; nor does the Library accept responsibility for the accuracy of the statements made in such materials.
